In resistance to narratives that pathologize marginalized sexualities, this program focuses on how to incorporate sex positive practices into therapy with queer and/or trans Black, Indigenous, and other People of Color (QTBIPOC). Theoretical frameworks exist to help us shift our language and actions toward more socially just and destigmatizing care. By utilizing intersectionality theory (Crenshaw, 1991) and embodiment (Krieger, 2001), this program illustrates the reciprocal relationship between the body and its social context within compounding systems of oppression.
